Conferences are the foundation of the Equine History Collective's mission to "support equine history research and its dissemination and promote collaboration between equine historians in all disciplines." We are pleased to report that the 2024 conference *Tech-quids across Time* was both an academic and a financial success, netting **\$813.99** in profit. Money from EHC 2024 goes toward the General Fund, which is used to pay for digital operating costs, licensing fees, and conference expenses.

As the "Money In" table above and pie chart to the left demonstrate, registration fees comprised the entirety of the conference's income. The pie chart shows all non-member registration fees in shades of teal (29.37% of paid registrants) and member registration fees in shades of green (68.53% of paid registrants). In order to

encourage participation from the Johnson & Wales community, the EHC waived registration for all JWU students and offered a discounted staff and faculty rate of \$30.00 (2.1% of paid registrants). In terms of actual attendees, non-members comprised 15.52% of those present, members 65.51%, and JWU affiliates 18.97%.

The "Money Out" table above and pie chart to the right detail the conference's expenses. Please note that shades of teal on the pie chart denote keynote-specific expenses, while green denotes the cost of Zoom Webinar to host the conference virtually. The keynote honoraria/um is an expected expense regardless of the conference's format, as we firmly believe in compensating individuals for their time and effort. This year, we presented each of our Keynotes with \$250 to express our gratitude for sharing their expertise with our organization.
